

Splash-Less & Low Splash Bleach



The sodium hypochlorite concentration in “splashless bleach” products is only 1 to 5 percent (compared to 8.25 percent in regular bleach). This is not strong enough to disinfect when mixed with water according to the rule (2 teaspoons bleach to 1 quart water).

Chlorox Splash-less bleaches and other similar products are not registered disinfectants. "Disinfects" or "Kills germs" will be on the label for a registered disinfectant.

When it comes to bleach, you can't just 'grab a gallon' and go. You really need to read the label carefully. “Regular” bleach is the ONLY kind you want for **disinfecting** the diapering surface.
