Established in 1973, Family Child Care, Inc., (FCCI) is an organization of licensed family child care providers committed to developing and promoting high quality child care in our community through education, resources, and support. FCCI's goals are to promote quality licensed child care; increase public awareness of family child care; increase communication and reduce the feeling of isolation among providers; provide support services such as workshops, newsletters, and a comprehensive provider website; represent the interests and concerns of providers; and provide mentors for prospective and licensed providers.

**FCCI in response to the 2013 legislative changes in Rule 2 and feedback from licensed family childcare providers are proposing legislative changes for 2014. It is the intent of these proposals to create consistency and simplicity to support family child care programs and uphold the safety for children in family child care programs.**

**Proposed:** A single transferable, background study for independent contractors serving multiple family child care programs within a county; study to be kept on file with county licensing unit, including the contractor/sub training record.

**Proposed:** SUIDS/AHT training every 2 years in approved training format; off year video.

**Proposed:** A correction order shall not be issued under **245A.1435** unless there is evidence that a violation occurred when an infant was present in the license holder's care.
