FCCI Announces new \$65 Membership Price for 2018

After thoughtful consideration, the board of directors has found it necessary to implement our first increase in 3 years in order to continue offering the best training and resources to our members.

PLEASE NOTE: *FCCI Workshops are designed as adult learning environments*****

FCCI is committed to providing an adult-only learning environment that is supportive of the educational needs of all of our members. Childcare is not available at the workshops and children within the area of instruction can be disruptive to both our trainer and other trainees. Therefore, with the exception of exclusively breastfed infants age three months and younger, children **may not** attend workshops or be left unattended in other areas of the church. Any breastfed infants age 0 - 3 months that attend should remain in room #2 and be removed if they become disruptive. FCCI is unable to issue training certificates to attendees who excuse themselves from workshops for more than 15 minutes for any reason.

There is a \$5 charge for training certificate replacement.

Please keep your training certificates in a secure location for licensing verification.

FCCI 2018 Membership Increase Q & A

Q: What will be the new price for the 2018 membership?

A: New membership prices will increase from \$50 per year to \$65 per year.

Q: Why are membership fees increasing?

A: FCCI is a non-profit organization that must set a budget each year to plan operating expenses. Our operating expenses have continued to increase each year, yet our membership fees have not increased since 2014.

Q: What is causing the increased budget demands for FCCI?

A: The strain on our budget has two primary sources.

- Training fees from MNCPD approved trainers have increased and many of the frequently requested specialty speakers now cost well over one thousand dollars each. It is becoming increasingly difficult to find free or low cost trainers who are willing to go through the MNCPD process. These low cost trainers used to offset the higher cost of premium speakers.

- FCCI is a non-profit organization run entirely by volunteers. As our membership numbers have increased, the number of volunteers willing to contribute to daily operations has actually decreased. This will require, at times, the board to outsource some tasks so FCCI can continue to operate efficiently with fewer hands.

Q: Is a FCCI membership worth \$65?

A: Yes! In fact, it's worth a lot more than that. FCCI members receive at least \$300 worth of trainings each year, free advertising on the FCCI website as well as advocacy, resources, networking opportunities and support.

Q: Why are you increasing membership fees when there is \$15,000 in the bank?

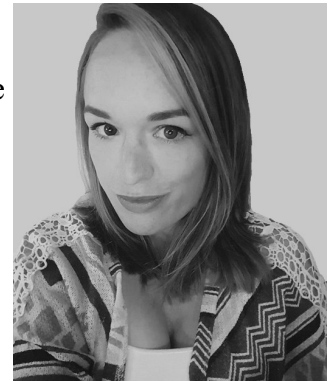
A: FCCI has a \$15,000 CD to protect our association from any number of unexpected expenses that may arise. For example, if the organization ever needed to hire an attorney to represent us in the event of a lawsuit or an IRS audit, those "emergency funds" would not last long but could help keep us operating. The CD provides stability, which has enabled us to invest all our annual revenue in trainings and expenses for that year's budget.

SUPERVISION & SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN LEAVING THE PREMISES **(Bus Stop, Off-site Activities, etc.)**



MN RULE 9502.0315 DEFINITIONS SUBP. 29A SUPERVISION

For the school age child, it means a caregiver being available for assistance and care so that the child's health and safety is protected.

The provider must have a current written statement from the parent regarding who is authorized to pick up the child and/or allowing the school age child to leave the premises. The provider must take into consideration the conditions that are present and have a plan to protect the health and safety of the child.

USE OF TEEN HELPERS IN FAMILY CHILD CARE

The family child care rule defines a helper as “a person at least 13 years of age and less than 18 years of age who assists the provider with the care of children”. The following information was provided by the Minnesota Department of Human Services.

Providers are responsible for the supervision of their helper(s), and are ultimately accountable for the actions of anyone assisting or having contact with children in care. Helpers can assist the provider with meal preparation, activities, interaction, or reading with the children. They can also provide a second set of eyes and ears, but should never be left alone in order to replace the provider’s own supervision of the children in care.

For the protection of teen helpers and the safety of children in care, providers should limit situations where a teen helper or child would be placed in a vulnerable situation, such as toileting, diapering, or interactions unsupervised by the provider. Providers should also have a frank discussion with their helper(s) regarding expectations and guidelines for their involvement with children. By doing so, providers are protecting everyone in their family child care home.

Olmsted County Licensing News

After careful consideration, if providers choose to use a teen helper, they must make sure their helper has met the following requirements:

1. A completed background study prior to assisting with the care of children.
2. Training on reducing the risks of sudden unexpected infant death prior to assisting with the care of infants.
3. Training on reducing the risk of abusive head trauma prior to assisting with the care of infants and children.
4. Completion of 6 hours of child care related training within the first year of employment.

Healthy Fruity Snowman Snack



Ingredients:

3 slices of banana
