Preschoolers: Understanding & Preventing Challenging Behaviors

Presenter: Rachel Daley

KCF: II.C Promoting Social & Emotional Development

This 2-hour behavior guidance course will meet the licensed family child care annual training requirement. 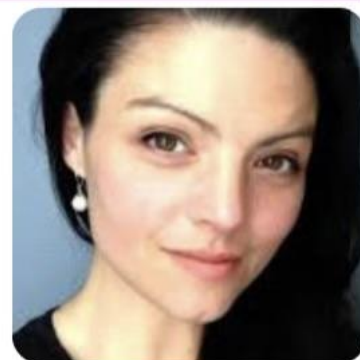

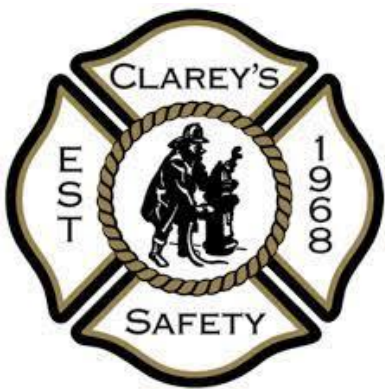

How To Make Easter Egg Popsicles



Equipment

- Plastic Easter eggs
- Popsicle sticks
- Pen to poke holes
- Squeeze bottle or small funnel

Ingredients

- 1 ½ cup mixed strawberries & raspberries
- 1 cup coconut milk
- ½ large banana

Instructions

- In a blender, blend strawberries, coconut milk and banana until liquidy with no chunks of fruit
- Line up your eggs so the pointy side of the eggs face down. Using a chopstick or a pen, poke a hole in each plastic egg on the widener side of the egg. Wash well after
- Fill a squeeze bottle with smoothie mix, Make sure your eggs are closed tightly, then carefully fill each egg with the smoothie mixture
- Add a lollipop stick to each egg in the hole in the egg
- Freeze the egg popsicles for a least 6 hrs or overnight

Flower Button Art Card for Mother's Day

Supplies: buttons, colorful cardstock, Elmer x-treme glue or hot glue gun, green foam sheets, and scissors

1. Fold an 8.5 x 11 of card stock in half
2. Stem -Cut some small strips of green foam and glue it
3. Glue some large buttons above the green stem, leaving a little space for the petals and allow time to dry
4. Glue smaller buttons around the large centers for the petals
5. Glue green buttons next to the foam stripes for the leaves and your card is finished

Please take this opportunity to nominate your child care provider in recognition and appreciation of the high quality of care, support, and professionalism that she/he provides to the families in her/his program and the field of family child care.

Nomination & Eligibility Guidelines

- Nominee has been an active licensed provider for a minimum of three (3) years who has not previously received this award within the last seven (7) years. The three year minimum is prior to the nomination deadline.
- Exhibits special competence as a child care provider.
- Demonstrates professional skills in child care and in community activities.
- Has made a positive impact on the lives of young children.
- Has future goals to further enhance her/his competency as a child care provider.
- Must plan to maintain an active childcare license for the next year.
- Must have no pending negative licensing actions, conditional or probation license or appeal, is not under investigation for a negative licensing action or have any substantiated complaints within the past three years. This does not include correction orders.
- Must be a licensed family child care provider operating in Southeastern Minnesota.

The nomination process is simple!

- Identify the provider you feel should be recognized.
- Fill out the nomination form on the reverse side.
- Write a letter of recommendation describing how the provider meets the guidelines, and how the provider has made a difference to your child and/or family.
- Mail completed nomination form (must be postmarked by March 1st to be considered for the outgoing year).
- The Provider of the Year award recipient will be honored at the annual Family Child Care, Inc. Olmsted County Provider Celebration training (typically the second Monday in May). Email questions to fcimn@gmail.com.
