Here's a helpful guide to help you decide on time outside:

Understand the Weather

Wind-Chill



- 30° is *chilly* and generally uncomfortable
- 15° to 30° is *cold*
- 0° to 15° is *very cold*
- -20° to 0° is *bitter cold* with significant risk of *frostbite*
- -20° to -60° is *extreme cold* and *frostbite* is likely
- -60° is *frigid* and exposed *skin will freeze* in 1 minute

Heat Index



- 80° or below is considered *comfortable*
 - 90° beginning to feel *uncomfortable*
 - 100° *uncomfortable* and may be *hazardous*
 - 110° considered *dangerous*
- All temperatures are in degrees Fahrenheit

Nomination & Eligibility Guidelines

- Nominee has been an active licensed provider for a minimum of three (3) years who has not previously received this award within the last seven (7) years. The three year minimum is prior to the nomination deadline.
- Exhibits special competence as a child care provider.
- Demonstrates professional skills in child care and in community activities.
- Has made a positive impact on the lives of young children.
- Has future goals to further enhance her/his competency as a child care provider.
- Must plan to maintain an active childcare license for the next year.
- Must have no pending negative licensing actions, conditional or probation license or appeal, is not under investigation for a negative licensing action or have any substantiated complaints within the past three years. This does not include correction orders.
- Must be a licensed family child care provider operating in Southeastern Minnesota.

The nomination process is simple!

- Identify the provider you feel should be recognized.
- Fill out the nomination form on the reverse side.
- Write a letter of recommendation describing how the provider meets the guidelines, and how the provider has made a difference to your child and/or family.
- Mail completed nomination form (must be postmarked by March 1st to be considered for the outgoing year).
- The Provider of the Year award recipient will be honored at the annual Family Child Care, Inc. Olmsted County Provider Celebration training (typically the second Monday in May). Email questions to fcimn@gmail.com.

Summer Crafts Idea & Recipe

Chalk Paint

Supplies :

- Leftover sidewalk pieces or new
- Ziplock sandwich bags / gallon freezer bags
- Rubber mallet/hammer
- Bowls or tupperware
- Muffin tin
- Water
- Paint brush

1. First sort all of the small broken chalk pieces by color into bowls or tupperware
2. Place each set of colored chalk into a ziplock bag (double bag it so it doesn't rip)
3. Used a rubber mallet or a hammer to crush the chalk pieces into a fine powder. Repeat this step until all the colors are done.
4. Poured each colored crush into an individual compartment in the muffin tin.
5. Mix in water a little bit at a time and use the paintbrushes to stir and create a paint consistency.
6. Start painting on your driveway

Bouncing Bubbles

Materials:

- ❑ 1 T Dish soap (Dawn works best)
- ❑ 2 T sugar
- ❑ Bubble wand or bubble machine
- ❑ Soft winter gloves

Directions:

Mix ingredients together and stir gently until sugar is dissolved in the liquid. Once the sugar is dissolved the bubble solution is ready. Blow bubbles manually or use them in a bubble machine. Have your littles wear soft winter gloves and let the bubbles land gently onto their gloves, then they can softly bounce the bubbles in their covered hands. (Bubbles will pop in contact with skin.)

Turn this into an experiment by seeing what types of materials keep the bubbles in tact.

Moon & Sand Recipe

Equipment

- Bowl
- Wooden spoon
- Measuring cup
- Airtight container (to store sand)
- Beach toys and/or play dough molds

Materials

- 8 cups All-purpose flour
- 1 cup Baby oil

Instructions:

1. Add 8 cups of flour to a large bowl
2. Add 1 cup of baby oil to the flour
3. Use a wooden spoon to stir the flour and baby oil together until combined. It takes about 5 minutes. It's done when the texture is consistent and the flour is moldable with a spoon. Use your hands to knead it near the end to make sure the flour at the bottom is mixed in.
4. Your moon sand is complete!

Notes: Having trouble getting your moon sand out of the mold? Make sure the mold is clean & dry. After using the mold a few times the sand begins to stick & it doesn't release as easily.

Milk & Cereal Popsicle Recipe

Supplies

- Popsicle mold
- Popsicle sticks
- Mixing bowl
- whisk

Ingredients

- 8 oz vanilla Greek yogurt
- ¾ cup milk (alternative: strawberry milk for a pretty pink color!)
- Fruity pebbles, to taste

Instructions:(Serves: 6)

In mixing bowl,combine yogurt and milk,whisk together until smooth. Pour into mold until ¼ full and sprinkle in about a tablespoon of Fruity Pebbles. Freeze for 4-6 hrs, repeat until mold is full and then freeze another additional 12 hrs. Remove and Enjoy!!

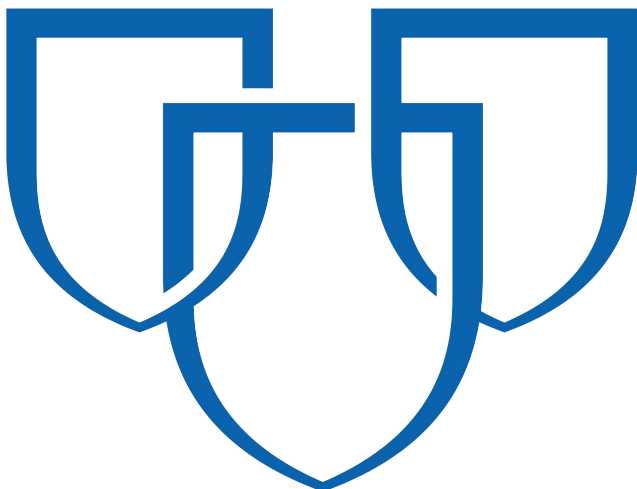
