Description: This class meets DHS Licensing training requirements for both Sudden Unexpected Infant Death (SUID) and Abusive Head Trauma (AHT). Content includes recommendation to reduce Sudden, Unexpected Infant Deaths (SUID) including SIDS, suffocation, and other sleep related infant deaths; safe sleep environments; MN Child Care regulations related to safe sleep; as well as symptoms and consequences of abusive head trauma, risk factors for abusive head trauma; strategies to use when stressed, angry or frustrated.

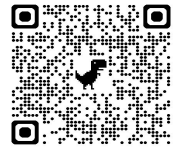

Nomination & Eligibility Guidelines

- Nominee has been an active licensed provider for a minimum of three (3) years who has not previously received this award within the last seven (7) years. The three year minimum is prior to the nomination deadline.
- Exhibits special competence as a child care provider.
- Demonstrates professional skills in child care and in community activities.
- Has made a positive impact on the lives of young children.
- Has future goals to further enhance her/his competency as a child care provider.
- Must plan to maintain an active childcare license for the next year.
- Must have no pending negative licensing actions, conditional or probation license or appeal, is not under investigation for a negative licensing action or have any substantiated complaints within the past three years. This does not include correction orders.
- Must be a licensed family child care provider operating in Southeastern Minnesota.

The nomination process is simple!

- Identify the provider you feel should be recognized.
- Fill out the nomination form on the reverse side.
- Write a letter of recommendation describing how the provider meets the guidelines, and how the provider has made a difference to your child and/or family.
- Mail completed nomination form (must be postmarked by March 1st to be considered for the outgoing year).
- The Provider of the Year award recipient will be honored at the annual Family Child Care, Inc. Olmsted County Provider Celebration training (typically the second Monday in May). Email questions to fcimn@gmail.com.

Fall Crafts Idea & Recipe

Leaf Prints

Materials:

- leaves
- washable paint
- cardstock paper
- art tray
- paint tray
- paintbrush

Directions:

- Grab some leaves from outside. Try to find the one that don't have any holes on them. This will make the prints turn out the best
- Paint the side of the leaf with ridges so they show up on the paper. Kids can use whatever colors they like or do fall colors
- Flip the leaf over and make sure to press down on the entire leaf to make the whole print show up
- Slowly lift it up, so make sure it doesn't get smudged

Sponge Painted Turkeys

Materials:

- sponges
- washable paint
- construction/cardstock paper
- googly eyes
- glue stick

Directions:

- Make a turkey face using your construction/cardstock paper and googly eyes
- Cut sponges into stripes, so it's easy for the kids to pick up and paint
- Create some feathers on white paper and cut them out
- Dip the sponges into the paint and make prints on the feathers! Let them dry, then use a glue stick to glue them to the back of the turkey

No-Bake Mini Pumpkin

Equipment:

- plastic spoons
- napkins or paper towels

Ingredients: (one per child)

- 1 vanilla pudding cup
- 1 tablespoon Libby's Easy Pumpkin Pie Mix
- 1 Keebler Mini Graham Cracker Pie Crust
- 1 squirt Reddi Whip whipped cream (optional)

Instructions:

1. Give each child a plastic spoon and a napkin or paper towel
2. Distribute one pudding cup to each child and have them remove the plastic or foiling covering
3. Have an adult drop a tablespoon of pumpkin pie mix into each putting cup
4. Have kids stir pumpkin pie mix into their pudding and give each one mini graham cracker pie crust
5. Keep each crusts in its foil dish and have them spoon their pumpkin pie mixture into the crust
6. Smooth and spread the mix with their spoon until they like the looks of it
7. Give each child a squirt of whipped cream

Banana Snowmen

Equipment:

- Wooden skewers or popsicle sticks

Popsicle sticks might be too short. If you use wooden skewers, find one that is safe for children

Ingredients:

- banana
- green grapes
- strawberries
- mini chocolate chips
- small slice of carrot

Instructions:

- Slice banana into ½ inch pieces. Place 3 of the slices on skewer.
- Cut the stem of the strawberries and add it to the skewer as the "hat".
- Poke 2 mini chocolate chips into the top banana for the eyes, and 2 or 3 into the second banana slice for the buttons
- Cut a small triangle out of the carrots slice and poke into the snowman's head as nose.

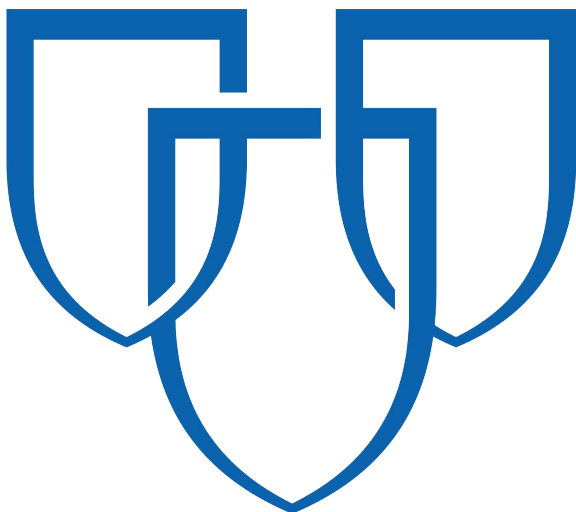
